## Gary Edwards Gym HVAC Upgrade Scope of Services

- Size and install new packaged Heat Pump type HVAC system with auxiliary electric strip heat and duct work to accommodate 100% capacity.
- Units are to be able to purge excess CO2 and economize fresh air as needed.
- Units are to be able to maintain between 50% and 60% relative humidity.
- Controls are to be of a remote type installed in Facility's Director's office.
- Equipment yards are to be rocked with concrete equipment pads.
- •Duct plenums and through the wall penetrations shall be of a Thermaduct or equivalent type product colored to match current exterior esthetics.
- interior air distribution system shall be of a sock ducting type.
- All exterior wall penetrations shall be air/ water tight sealed.
