2.c PROCEDURES FOR ROAD CLOSING

Road Closing must comply with Florida Statutes, Chapter 336.

- 1. Obtain application for Road Closing from County Coordinator's Office at 224 Pine Avenue.
- 2. Complete application and return it to the County Coordinator's Office along with the \$500 fee and a copy of a vicinity map.
- 3. The County Coordinator's Office will prepare a legal notice for the newspaper. Florida Statutes requires that the notice of Road Closing be published in a newspaper of general publication in the County al least two weeks prior to the hearing.
- 4. All adjoining landowners on road will be notified in writing of the hearing by the County Coordinator, and a sign which gives notice of the hearing, will be posted on the road.
- 5. At the public hearing the Board will hear the applicant and any other interested parties. The Board may either adopt a resolution closing the road or deny the request.
- 6. If the Board approves the closing of the road, then the lands shall revert back to the adjoining landowners, pursuant to Florida Law
